

Bible Study Lesson 2

I Will Trust in the Lord Psalm 27:10-11

Trusting in the Lord means that we believe that God is in control. As we are presently under a mandate to stay at home, we still proclaim that God is in control. Although we are following the guidelines of our medical professionals and government officials we are trusting in the Lord. This lockdown could have a negative effect on us emotionally but let us choose to make a positive impact on people by demonstrating a good attitude. Our text reminds us of three ways we can increase our trust in the Lord.

- I. God will take care of me. (vs. 10)
 - A. He will not neglect you
 - B. He will nurture you.
- II. God can teach me. (vs. 11a)
 - A. We are taught by the written word
 - B. We are taught by the spoken word

- III. God can lead me. (vs. 11b)
 - A. Presence of the Holy Spirit
 - B. Peace of mind
